

Research on the Challenges and Countermeasures of the Optimization and Adjustment of Foreign Trade Dependence in Guangzhou

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Abstract: This paper studies the challenges and countermeasures of the optimization and adjustment of Guangzhou's foreign trade dependence. By analyzing the historical evolution of Guangzhou's foreign trade dependence, its impact on economic growth and dependence on the external economic environment, it reveals its shortcomings in market diversification, industrial structure and enterprise innovation ability. In view of these problems, the market diversification strategy, industrial structure upgrading and optimization countermeasures to improve the innovation ability of enterprises are put forward. Only through various comprehensive measures can we effectively reduce the risks caused by excessive dependence on foreign trade in Guangzhou and promote the sustainable development of its economy.

Traditional manufacturing occupies an important position in Guangzhou's foreign trade, but these industries are facing the pressure of technological upgrading and transformation, and many enterprises have not completed the transformation from low-end manufacturing to high-end manufacturing, resulting in insufficient added value and technical content of export products. At the same time, the development of emerging industries is relatively lagging behind, although Guangzhou has a certain foundation in the fields of information technology, biomedicine, new energy and other fields, but the proportion of these industries in foreign trade is still small, failing to give full play to their growth potential. This irrational industrial structure not only affects the overall quality and competitiveness of Guangzhou's foreign

trade, but also limits the sustainable development of its economy.

3.3 Insufficient Innovation Ability of Enterprises

Although Guangzhou has many foreign trade enterprises, these enterprises generally lack technology research and development and innovation capabilities, which seriously restricts their international competitiveness. Many foreign trade enterprises have obviously insufficient investment in technology research and development, resulting in the low technical content and innovation of their products, making it difficult to meet the needs of high-quality and high-tech products in the international market. The innovation mechanism and management model within the enterprise are relatively backward, and there is a lack of effective incentive mechanism and innovation culture, resulting in the low conversion rate of innovative achievements, and many R&D achievements cannot be applied to actual production in time. At the same time, foreign trade enterprises in Guangzhou lack brand influence and market voice in the global market. The products are mainly OEM and OEM production, and have failed to form an independent brand with international competitiveness. This not only affects the profit level of the enterprise, but also limits its market expansion ability and long-term development potential. The lack of enterprise innovation ability makes Guangzhou's position in the global industrial chain relatively low-end, and it is difficult to obtain higher added value and stronger competitiveness in the international market.

4. Optimization Countermeasures for the Dependence of Foreign Trade in Guangzhou

4.1 Market Diversification Strategy

Guangzhou needs to vigorously expand emerging markets and reduce excessive dependence on traditional markets. At present, Guangzhou's foreign trade market is mainly concentrated in Europe, the United States and some Asian countries. This high market concentration makes it particularly vulnerable in the face of international market fluctuations. Therefore, Guangzhou should actively expand trade cooperation with emerging markets such as Africa, Latin America and the Middle East,

and open up more export channels by strengthening economic exchanges with countries in these regions. In particular, by participating in the Belt and Road Initiative, we can establish closer economic cooperation with countries along the route, and expand the scale of trade with these countries and enhance market diversification with the help of the construction of international channels.

Guangzhou should also strengthen regional economic cooperation and expand the scope of foreign trade by signing more free trade agreements (FTAs), taking advantage of the tariff reduction and market access facilitated by FTA. By signing free trade agreements with more countries and regions, Guangzhou can establish broader and more stable trade partnerships around the world, reduce single market risks, and enhance foreign trade risk resistance. At the same time, Guangzhou should actively participate in global economic governance, promote the formulation and improvement of trade rules, and create a fairer and more transparent international trade environment for foreign trade enterprises. The implementation of the market diversification strategy is not only conducive to diversifying market risks, but also enhances Guangzhou's competitiveness and influence in the international market, and promotes the optimization and adjustment of foreign trade dependence, as shown in Table 1.

improve the overall competitiveness, and enhance the modernization level of traditional industries through the introduction of advanced production technology and management mode, so that they can maintain a dominant position in the fierce international competition. Guangzhou also needs to accelerate the development of strategic emerging industries, the development of emerging industries can not only inject new growth momentum for Guangzhou's economy, but also seize the opportunity in the global industrial transformation. Improving the innovation ability of enterprises will not only help to enhance the competitiveness of foreign trade enterprises, but also promote the optimization and upgrading of the foreign trade structure and promote the sustainable development of Guangzhou's economy. At the same time, the government should improve the intellectual property protection system, ensure the innovative achievements of enterprises, and stimulate the innovation enthusiasm and creativity of enterprises. Through a series of measures, Guangzhou can gradually improve the innovation ability of enterprises and realize the optimization and adjustment of foreign trade dependence.
