

The Status and Development Pathways of Digital Resource Libraries in Community Education in China

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Abstract: The construction of digital resource libraries in community education in China is an essential initiative to promote educational equity and lifelong learning. This study aims to comprehensively analyze the status of these digital resource libraries and explore future development pathways. 4.3 Diversity and Quality Control of Resource Content

These databases often lack diverse resource types, limiting the supply of varied learning resources and failing to meet users' diverse learning needs. The quality of resource content is inconsistent. Some resource databases have poor quality, with outdated content, slow updates, and frequent errors, ultimately affecting users' learning outcomes. The quality control mechanisms are inadequate, lacking proper review and evaluation processes to ensure the quality and effectiveness of the provided resources.

5. International Experience and Insights

5.1 Experiences from Developed Countries in Building Community Education Digital Resource Databases

The United States' National Digital Library Program (NDLP) has established a national digital resource database by integrating library resources nationwide, providing community residents with abundant learning resources and convenient services. The United Kingdom's National Electronic Library Project (NELP) utilizes advanced information technology to build a comprehensive, user-friendly resource database platform that offers diverse learning resources and services. Australia's National Education Resource Pool (NER) has created an open and cooperative educational resource platform through collaboration among the government, schools, and communities, promoting fair distribution and efficient utilization of educational resources.

5.2 Insights from International Best Practices for China

Government policy support and top-level design play a crucial role in building resource databases. Strengthening policy support, formulating unified standards and norms, and promoting the construction and development of resource databases are necessary. Diverse collaboration is key to building resource databases. Drawing on the successful experiences of other countries, promoting multi-party cooperation among the government, schools, communities, and enterprises to jointly build and maintain resource pools is essential.
